Lesson Objective	"We will role play situations of conflict."	"We will complete quickwrites, and join in the jigsaw activity group work."	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>An administrator catches a student using their cell phone in the cafeteria</li> <li>A teacher can't find your assignment even though you know that you turned it in</li> <li>A teacher counted a question wrong on a test that you actually got right</li> <li>A counselor says that you need to not sign up for Honors-level classes</li> <li>A teacher accuses you of throwing something in class even though it was someone else</li> <li>A teacher gives you a grade on a project or paper that is lower than what you feel you deserve</li> <li>An administrator accuses you of cursing in the hall even though it was actually someone else</li> <li>An administrator catches you for a dress code violation</li> <li>An administrator accuses you of bullying another student even though you were just playing</li> <li>Your AVID teacher assigns you to a tutorial group where you don't like the tutor</li> </ul>
